



Adopt-A-Roadway Program- Application and Guidelines for Participation

The City of Dardenne Prairie Adopt-A-Roadway program gives individuals and groups an opportunity to support anti-litter and beautification efforts by adopting a section of City roadway for the purpose of litter collection.

Thanks for your interest in participating.

- The Adopt-A-Roadway Program is open to any individual, group, business or families within the City of Dardenne Prairie.
- An administrative fee of \$25 for first time adopters and a renewal fee of \$10 are required
- Program participants must be a minimum of 10 years of age. **NO** one under the age of 10 may participate in the litter collection due to safety concerns. Groups with members under the age of 18 must be supervised by an adult 21 years of age or older. At least 1 adult is required on site for every 5 participants less than 18 years old.
- A youth participation release form must be signed and returned to the City of Dardenne Prairie for all children under the age of 18 participating in the program
- Adopters are requested to adopt a ½ to 2 mile section of City road for a minimum period of two years.
- Litter should be collected from the adopted road as needed. Adopters must collect litter from their adopted roadway no less than four times a year.
- Litter collections can only be conducted between one hour after sunrise and one hour before sunset, in fair weather during non-rush hour traffic times.
- Adopters may be canceled by the City for failure to pick up litter in a timely manner or for unruly behavior while picking up the litter.
- Adopt-A-Roadway signs, including the adopters' name, will be installed along each of the adopted sections.
- The City will have final approval of all wording on signs.
- Safety cones, vest, trash bags and trash collection tools will be provided for use during scheduled clean-up sessions by the City.
- A designated group leader will be required for each group to serve as the liaison with the City of Dardenne Prairie. The group leader will be responsible for signing the adoption agreement, scheduling the clean-up dates, checking out and returning clean-up and safety gear, and ensuring compliance with clean-up and safety procedures.

3. The Group agrees that in the event the group leader is changed during the participation of the Group in the Adopt-A-Roadway Program, the group will provide in writing to the City of Dardenne Prairie the new name, address and telephone numbers of the new Group Leader.
4. The Group hereby releases the City of Dardenne Prairie, its agents and employees from any liability for damages or injuries resulting from its participation in the City of Dardenne Prairie Adopt-A-Roadway Program.
5. The City of Dardenne Prairie has the right to reject any Group from participating in the Adopt-A-Roadway Program and has the right to terminate any adoption contract if the terms of this contract are not fulfilled, or if the Group has displayed characteristics that may be construed as demeaning to another particular group.
