There will be color stations along the route spraying FDA approved, food grade, corn starch infused with bright colors onto the runners which will wash away with water. It is biodegradable. They will exit ICD at White Birch Lane and proceed north on Hanley to Pheasant Meadow Drive, turn around at Pheasant Meadow Drive and head South on Hanley to west on Feise to Technology. Turn around at Technology head East on Feise, South on Hanley and back to White Birch Lane. ICD will use water buckets to clean the streets after the event. They have had their route approved by the Sheriff's Dept., Fire and Ambulance. A run map is included as well as approval from Fire, Ambulance and Sheriff's Department.






